## **PREFACE**

The Emergency Conservation Program (ECP) is authorized in Title IV of the Agricultural Credit Act of 1978, Public Law 95-334, approved October 1, 1978, as amended by the Disaster Assistance Act of 1989, Section 502. Funding for the program is appropriated by the Congress.

The ECP provides emergency funds for sharing with farmers and ranchers the cost of rehabilitating farmland damaged by wind, erosion, floods, hurricanes, or other natural disasters, and for carrying out emergency water conservation measures during periods of severe drought.

The Farm Service Agency (FSA) of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) administers the ECP. The county FSA committees may implement the ECP when conditions so warrant (except for drought) with concurrence by the State FSA committee. For severe drought, the designation shall be determined by the Deputy Administrator for Farm Programs, FSA.

This summary contains the National and State data for all practice payments made during the 2006 fiscal year and, also, cumulative data from years 1952 through 2006.
