

OSHA Publications Are Available On-Line

The U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has made its booklets and publications available in electronic format on its web site: <http://www.osha-slc.gov/oshdoc/additional.html>. Go to this site and click on the title of the publication you wish to view.

Because of the size of the documents, the site tells you to save the PDF files directly to your hard disk, rather than viewing them through your browser or plug-in viewer.

Since many of them are produced in Adobe PDF (to retain their original layout), you must have Adobe Acrobat Reader (version 3.0 or higher) to view these documents. You can obtain Acrobat Reader through the site.
