

# SCOPE OF POLICY



- Clarifies EPA's Role
- Encourages Cooperation
- Promotes Consistency
- Minimizes Duplication of Efforts
- Improves Effectiveness of Cleanup at FUDS

- Coordination with USACE & Other Parties
- Site Assessment
- FUDS Inventory
- Site Screening
- Preliminary Assessment





# ENFORCEMENT

- Use of Existing Policies
- Consistent with Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, & Liability Act (CERCLA) and the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP)
- NOT Limited Solely to CERCLA

# POLICY SUMMARY



- Clarifies EPA'S Role on Environmental Investigations & Cleanups of Privately-Owned FUDS.
- States EPA'S Role in Site Assessment of FUDS, Overseeing and Implementing Response Actions at FUDS, and Enforcement Alternatives Available to EPA.
- Does Not Establish Any New Requirements or Responsibilities for EPA or Other Stakeholders.
