## Workshop on National Air Toxics Monitoring: Data Analysis and Network Design

On May 13 – 14, 2003, the Lake Michigan Air Directors Consortium will host a workshop on the results of an extensive analysis of air toxics monitoring data. The data analyses, which are being performed by Battelle Memorial Institute and Sonoma Technology, Inc., focus on the data from the 10-city pilot monitoring program conducted during 2001-2002. The purpose of the analyses is to develop recommendations for the design of the national air toxics monitoring network. These recommendations are also expected to be helpful to governmental and private organizations conducting air toxics monitoring.

Agenda: The workshop will start at 9:00 am CST on May 13 and end at noon on May 14. Presentations will be given on inter-laboratory variability, treatment of minimum detection levels, monitoring data variability, case studies, and other analyses (e.g., the air quality impact of diesel emissions, source apportionment studies, and examination of metals concentrations by particle size). The presentations will emphasize network design recommendations, and will address the initial roll-out of a national trends network, as well as ideas for additional national monitoring.
