

Processed Livestock/Poultry Manure
(Including processed poultry litter)

The European Union has not published a unified import certificate for the import of processed manure. Therefore, individual countries may require variations in the below certificate. Exporters should be especially diligent to have their importers confirm prior to export with the Ministry of Agriculture of the importing country that the issued certificate meet all entry requirements.

Health attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, declare that I have read and understood Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002⁽³⁾ and Regulation (EC) No 780/2004 and certify that the processed manure described above :</p> <p>9.1. comes from a technical plant, a biogas plant, or a composting plant approved by the competent authority in accordance with Regulation (EC) 1774/2002; and</p> <p>9.2 has been subjected to a heat treatment process of at least 70°C for at least 60 minutes or to an equivalent treatment in accordance with rules laid down under the procedure referred to in Article 33(2) of Regulation (EC) 1774/2002; and</p> <p>9.3 is free from salmonella (no salmonella in 25 g treated product); and</p> <p>9.4 is free from enterobacteriaceae (based on the aerobic bacterial count < 1 000 cfu per gram of treated products); and</p> <p>9.5 has been subjected to a reduction in spore-forming bacteria and toxic formation; and</p> <p>9.6 has been stored in such a way that, once processed, contamination or secondary infection and dampness is impossible. Therefore, they have been stored in:</p> <p>i) well-sealed and insulated silos, or</p> <p>ii) properly sealed packs (plastic bags or 'big bags').</p>
