Pests on the “lists”

- Several hundred pests on regulated pest list
- Ranked all them by how many times they appeared on a list
- How many interceptions for each
- Narrowed down to 30 pests
- Then down to 18 or so

Pest Lists

National Leadership in use of pest lists
consists of:

- Use of EAN, SITC and PIN-309 databases
- Regulated Pest list
- Use of various lists from Professional groups
- Availability of pest biological data

Future Lists

- Development of commodity based lists (need to get state comm. input)
- Reg. CAPS Comm. to supply support for flexibility in states survey list where possible
- GPDD; share data sheets with others
- Future—use of off-shore pest information
