IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF BAHRAIN FOR PETS EXPORTED
FROM THE UNITED STATES

1. An import permit is required from the Bahrain Veterinary Services prior to the export of the pet.
2. Dogs must be vaccinated against rabies, canine distemper, and parvo virus.
3. Cats must be vaccinated against rabies and feline distemper.
4. All pet birds must be vaccinated against Newcastle. Pigeons must also be vaccinated against pigeon pox.

Since the U.S. is not rabies-free, a statement should be added to the health certificate stating that the cat/dog is from an area which has been free from rabies for at least a year.
