

I visited with Dr. Arthur Furst recently and he indicated an interest in decreasing some of his activities in non-tobacco areas in order to concentrate on current "nonsmoker" problems facing the tobacco industry. He proposes to commence a review of carbon monoxide, nicotine and particulates as they may relate to claimed exposures of nonsmokers. He would also look into testing methods, standards for indoor air quality and related technical matters. His primary emphasis would probably be on particulates.

We recommend funding for a special project at a cost of about \$12,000 annually for the continuing review and approximately \$3,000 annually for travel and other expenses. The project should be authorized for two years at this time, a commitment of \$30,000.

Dr. Gardner has reviewed and approved this proposal.
