Last year the budget for Dr. Seltzer's project was \$60,000.00. He is now requesting an increase to \$70,000.00 to support his work for the period July 1, 1979, through June 30, 1980. The reasons for the requested increase include general inflation, increased travel expense for lectures, and other expense items.
