Dr. Seltzer's current project, funded in the amount of \$70,000.00, will terminate June 30, 1981. He is requesting a renewal for the period July 1, 1981, through June 30, 1982, at the same level.

The past year has been a busy one for Dr. Seltzer. His editorial in the September, 1980 issue of the American Heart Journal received a substantial amount of publicity, both national and international. He was asked to write a chapter on smoking and CHD which is to be published this summer in a monograph on tobacco by North Carolina Center for Public Policy Research, Inc.
