Proposed Special Project Renewal
Salvaggio/Lehrer

I refer to your letter of October 28 suggesting a two-year renewal of this project for a total of \$122,664 (\$58,055 + \$64,609).

Because Dr. Spears has consulted with you from time-to-time on Dr. Salvaggio's work, I am seeking his further guidance regarding its continuation.

I am aware of Dr. Spears' visit with you to New Orleans some months ago, at which time Alex tells me you reviewed the then-status of the project, and were advised generally of the proposed direction of the renewal work. We also understand that the renewal proposes to take the next steps in human clinical work - a direction with which we strongly agree.

In the meantime, perhaps you could furnish Alex and me with copies of the Doctors' proposal.

I notice that this project has moved back and forth over its five-year life from CTR to non-CTR Special Project status. Is there a reason it is not now to be renewed under CTR aegis?

During our September 10 discussion of Special Projects at the Chadbourne office, it was agreed by the Committee of Counsel that, where time and other circumstances permitted, we would endeavor to review Special Project requests at Committee meetings. Do you require a response on this renewal prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Committee on December 10?
