Gentlemen:

Dr. Seltzer has requested renewal of his CTR Special Project for the period July 1, 1983, through June 30, 1984, in the amount of \$70,000. Dr. Seltzer's current project, funded in the same amount, will terminate June 30, 1983.

Dr. Seltzer has been very active in the past year analyzing literature dealing with coronary heart disease (CHD) and advancing his views on the smoking and CHD issue. In particular, he spent a great deal of time reviewing the results of the Multiple Risk Factor Intervention Trial (MRFIT). In this regard, the Journal of the American Medical Association recently published his letter commenting on the MRFIT findings (copy enclosed). Dr. Seltzer also presented his views about smoking and CHD and MRFIT in a written statement to the Waxman Subcommittee.

Dr. Seltzer has been involved in other areas as well. He has met with active smoking and health researchers and communicated extensively with Professor Philip Burch on a variety of issues. In addition, he has continued to work with Dr. Bea van den Berg and her staff on their joint study of smoker/nonsmoker differences in adolescents.
