
Re: Dr. Carl C. Seltzer

Gentlemen:

Dr. Seltzer has requested renewal of his CTR Special Project for the period July 1, 1985, through June 30, 1986, in the amount of \$70,000. Dr. Seltzer's current project, funded in the same amount, will terminate June 30, 1985.

Dr. Seltzer has remained active in the past year analyzing literature dealing with heart disease and advancing his scientific views on the relationship between smoking and heart disease. He has corresponded with several medical journals and researchers regarding developments in smoking and health, especially on issues relating to intervention studies. Moreover, Dr. Seltzer has remained active as a researcher and recently has published important work on "smoker/nonsmoker differences in adolescents."

Finally, we have discussed Dr. Seltzer's project with Dr. Sommers at CTR and he favors its renewal. We also recommend approval of the project.
