

Re: Dr. Roger L. Bick

Gentlemen:

For several years, Dr. Roger Bick's research on lung cancer has been supported under a Council for Tobacco Research Special Project. Dr. Bick has requested that his grant be renewed so that he can continue the work. We recommend that this request be approved in the amount of \$39,691.32 to cover Dr. Bick's study expenses in 1989-1990 (see attached budget page).

Dr. Bick is a practicing oncologist-hematologist who has been conducting clinical research on the incidence of lung cancer since 1978. His 10-year report from 1978-1987 regarding lung cancer incidence in Kern County, California is enclosed. With over 1400 cases collected, this ongoing project may now represent one of the largest community-based studies of lung cancer in this country. Dr. Bick is currently analyzing the database and hopes to compare his results with other national and international data regarding lung cancer incidence.

Dr. Bick's proposal has been reviewed by the Council for Tobacco Research and has been approved. We recommend that Dr. Bick's research be continued as a CTR Special Project.
