At the request of Senator Cook of  
Kentucky, Dr. Yerushalmy has submitted comments  
for the record which are helpful to us. If you  
desire a copy, I shall be happy to forward it.

In addition, I have had a request that  
the industry grant a sum of \$5,000 to Dr. Sterling,  
whose recent article implicated air pollution and  
tended to exonerate cigarette smoking with respect  
to chronic obstructive lung diseases. The \$5,000  
would be used to continue the work of his organiza-  
tion in this area, which has become particularly  
valuable to the Institute Staff following Presi-  
dent Nixon's health message to Congress on Janu-  
ary 31, which contained statements I would ascribe  
to Dr. Horn implicating cigarette smoking. Our  
share of this would be about \$350 and I strongly  
recommend that we go forward. //
