Enclosed is a copy of the Kaiser Foundation Research Institute of California application to the Council for Tobacco Research for a research grant to study the Foundation's data on the characteristics of smokers and nonsmokers. You will note that Dr. Carl Seltzer is a co-investigator on this project. He will be personally involved in writing up the material and is quite enthusiastic about the project.

I have talked with Dr. Hockett and he is of the opinion that, while the project is favored by the CTR staff, the Scientific Advisory Board probably will not fund the project.

It is my belief that this project could well produce extremely valuable support for the proposition that reported differences in the health of smokers and nonsmokers may be accounted for by constitutional differences. The reason for sending the enclosed documents to you is so that you will be familiar with the project in the event it is not funded, in which event we can explore the possibility of making this a special project rather than turning the application down.

While I realize the attachment appears somewhat formidable, I suggest that the thrust of the project can be derived
