

In recent discussions, Professor Eysenck has advanced the idea of further exploring possible relationships among smoking, personality and lung cancer on a cross-cultural basis. Enclosed is a copy of a letter outlining the proposal and including a budget. Professor Eysenck proposes to carry out the work in a three year period budgeting \$40,000 for the first year, \$42,000 for the second year and \$45,000 for the third year.

Dr. Sommers has reviewed this proposal and enthusiastically approves it. Accordingly, we recommend that you approve this proposal as a CTR Special Project.
