I received a copy of Tom Hoyt's letter to you dated November 22, concerning the proposed budget of the Council for 1966...

I called Mr. Hoyt to make sure that there was nothing in his letter which runs counter to what I told you in my memo of several days ago; namely, that those grants in areas inspired by Doctors Little and Hackett, which will have SAB approval, are intended to be within the budget, but that a supplemental budget may be necessary, depending upon scope and amount of time required to complete these things.

As you know, there will be a separate budget to take care of any research activities which may be inspired by the industry and which does not fall within the Council on SAB budget.
