

During the May meeting of the Committee of Counsel, Bill Shinn presented a request from Dr. Seltzer to obtain an electronic word processor for his use in the preparation of manuscripts, reports, etc., in the work that he is pursuing. Subsequently, Dr. Seltzer has continued his survey of the available equipment and has requested the purchase of a WANG system which he feels will best fit his needs. The cost of the equipment, installed in Dr. Seltzer's office, is approximately \$8,500. In accordance with suggestions made at the May General Counsel meeting, we would purchase and "own" the word processing equipment but it would be delivered to and used by Dr. Seltzer. The cost of this equipment would be billed to Special Account #4.

I trust the above arrangement is agreeable to you and unless we hear from you to the contrary by July 12, 1982, we will make a ten percent (10%) order deposit with the supplier at that time.
