TO LEGAL COUNSEL:

Enclosed herewith is a resume' of an editorial entitled "Lung Cancer and Polluted Air" from the British Medical Journal of October 15, 1955, Pages 954 and 955. Please place this article in Volume V. "Air Pollution" as Page 32.

We call your particular attention to the last two paragraphs of the resume', emphasizing the difference in benzo(a)pyrene inhalations between Liverpool and rural atmospheres.

We are also enclosing an abstract of a report by Dr. P. R. Peacock entitled "Experimental Cigarette Smoking by Domestic Fowls" which was published in the British Journal of Cancer, Volume IX, No. 3, Pages 461-463, September 1955. This is to be placed in Volume V, "Animal Experiments" as Page 46.

The summary of an article by Drs. R. L. Cooper, J. A. S. Gilbert and A. J. Lindsey entitled "Polycyclic Hydrocarbons in Cigarette Smoke: The Contribution made by the Paper" published in the British Journal of Cancer, Volume IX, No. 3, Pages 442-445, September 1955 is also enclosed. This is to be placed in Volume V under the section headed "Chemistry of Smoke" as Page 22.

Enclosed also is one page for inclusion in Volume VI, Item 1955 c, which is a statement made by Dr. C. P. Rhoads, and which appears on Page 42 of the Biennial Report of the Sloan-Kettering Institute for Cancer Research (July 1, 1953 to June 30, 1955).
