Gentlemen:


Our firm has had a consultancy arrangement with Dr. Murray Senkus during the past year. The contract for consultancy services was funded through Special Fund 4 at an amount of \$2,500.00 per month plus expenses. Dr. Senkus spent one-half of his available time working under this contract with our firm. The other half of his time was spent working under a similar consultancy agreement with Covington & Burling.

During 1980-81 Dr. Senkus has worked closely with Dr. Alex Spears in exploring potential research areas and formulating proposals. Much of his time under the contract with our firm was spent on issues related to public smoking.

We have discussed the consultancy with Dr. Spears and he feels that Dr. Senkus is a good resource and should be retained as a consultant. We agree with his assessment and recommend that Dr. Senkus' consultancy contract with our firm be extended for another year under the same conditions and compensation.
