This is to confirm our discussion on February 7 with regard to the contemplated consideration of the several undertakings of A. D. Little Company.

I have requested that Charlie Kensler forward to each of you a copy of the rough drafts of the material which he has previously sent to some of us. You will recall that there was an authorization by you for Dr. Kensler to do further analysis of statistical work for an amount which he tells me was approximately \$50,000. This was handled through Fred Haas, although the billings have been to me. His company was also engaged by contract with me to update Parts 3 and 4 of their previous work which included the ingredients of smoke and animal experimentation. Thus far, A. D. Little Company has been paid in excess of \$79,000 and Dr. Kensler estimates that the approximate cost of completing the projects will be in the neighborhood of \$30,000 additional.

As you decided, I am asking Dr. Kensler to complete these projects as quickly as possible, but when you have received the drafts of work already done, it will be appreciated if you will pass on to Dr. Kensler, either directly or through me, any suggestions that you or any of your company people may have in regard to this work.
