Re: Dr. George Saiger

George Saiger dropped in yesterday and stated that he has been obtaining on a confidential basis a monthly bibliography on smoking and health from the National Library of Medicine and that he obtains this before the Clearing House. He has to date studied articles of interest and feels that the only way he can continue to be of value to us is to do just this. He stated that it is almost impossible to keep "cranked up" when a given emergency arises.

He would like to be retained to keep current at the rate of \$1500 a month with extra fees for testimony and special projects.

He stated that the 6th International Biometric Conference meets in Sydney, Australia commencing August 20 followed by the 36th Session of the International Statistical Institute. If we would pay his transportation, or half of it, he would act on our behalf.

I enclose a copy of his abstract and his discussion with Dr. Cochran held at the 35th Session of the International Statistical Institute. You will note that he also believes that a multivariate study should be undertaken.

We should consider this promptly, particularly his suggestion that he be on hand at the Sydney meetings.
