Enclosed are two copies of the accountants' report, covering operation of the Central File for the six months' period ended February 28, 1967. This is being submitted for the six months' period in accordance with my memorandum of October 27, 1964 and, in view of the present level of expenses, I would propose to submit a further statement six months hence. Please note that the item of \$2,662.67, which includes certain travel expenses, includes only such expenses incurred in September 1966, prior to the time when it was agreed that such expenses would be borne by the individual companies. Should anyone have any question about any item or items, or wish greater detail concerning any item or items, please let me know so that we may provide the answer or information.

As you can see from the accountants' report, the time has come for me to request a contribution from each of you to the expenses of the Central File and I would suggest that this contribution be in the amount of \$5,000 per company. This should be sufficient to finance Central File activities for some months. If not inconvenient, please make checks payable to Cabell Medinger Forsyth & Decker -- Special Account No. 3.
