Yesterday we received word from 31 that the thesaurus for the legal information storage and retrieval system -- scheduled for completion by November 10 -- was ready. A copy of their letter is attached for your information, and copies of the thesaurus are now being mailed out to each user.

The thesaurus, which is the last in a series of user tools that 31 has been preparing as part of the development of the system, is a listing of all the related index terms corresponding to each index term used as a descriptor. Detailed instructions on how to use the thesaurus in formulating search questions are set forth at the beginning of the volume. The Project Officer will also be in touch with all users to give further assistance regarding its use.
