

National Parklands in Alaska



The National Park Service manages 16 units and two affiliated areas in Alaska totaling more than 54 million acres. These parks attract 2 million visits a year. In addition to recreational and educational opportunities, Alaska's parks provide habitat for a vast variety of wildlife and protection for archaeological and historical resources.


Park Unit Boundaries
